Charter & Mission

CHARTER

The Inter-Service Survey Coordination Committee (ISSCC) facilitates survey coordination among the DoD Components, is chaired by the OPA Survey Program's Division Director, and consists of a representative from each of the Military Services and Health Affairs, as well as representatives from other organizations to address specific issues, as applicable.



MISSION

- Foster development of effective survey programs among the DoD Components.
- Collaborate and coordinate on information collections and issues relevant to all DoD survey programs to minimize respondent burden and costs to DoD by eliminating unnecessary duplication.
- Communicate information to tailor and align DoD survey programs with USD(P&R) initiatives and DoD objectives, including strengthening and promoting individual and mission readiness, family support and well-being.
- Meet at least semi-annually or when called by the chair.
- Provide content and planned dates of surveys, before fielding, to fellow ISSCC members.
